



POLICE REPORT – JULY 2017

In June we received 403 calls from members of the public relating to incidents across the three parishes.

Crime Alert

June saw Glenfield subject to 8 burglaries, with Kirby Muxloe having 2 and LFE 5. We would like to remind the public to be vigilant to suspicious behavior and report any to us directly at the time.

Being security conscious is the smart choice and we encourage you take appropriate precautions to reduce the possibility of becoming a victim of crime.

April also saw Glenfield have 13 vehicle related crimes reported to us. Kirby Muxloe also had 2 with LFE having 4.

Anti-Social Behaviour

Neighbour disputes have been the main focus of the beat team's attention this month with several being investigated. Where possible residents should seek to amicably resolve a problem, however, if communication breaks down to a point whereby the problem is persisting and causing people harassment alarm or distress then we are here to assist by mediating between parties to come to a resolution to ongoing problems. Please don't suffer in silence, let us know about it so we can assist in resolving the matter.

There was also a report of drug use by road users around Stamford Street in Glenfield. Details have been passed to the Police and the investigation is ongoing at this time.

Community Engagement

The beat team were available at a crime prevention event at the Parish Hall in LFE offering advice about home security.

An overweight vehicles operation was also ran for lorries entering Main Street in Kirby Muxloe. Although no lorries came through at the time, we intend on repeating the operation several times a year in response to the numerous complaints around this issue.
